

Auxiliary Services are provided to Incarnation School through the State of Ohio with Centerville City Schools as public school administrator. The services are funded by state and federal programs.

The counselor, Mrs. Pierce, and the nurse, Mrs. Woeste, are located in the school building. The remainder of the Auxiliary staff is located in the **Academic Resource Center (ARC)**, behind the school.

## Auxiliary Services

- Clinic staffed by full time School Nurse

Incarnation students' eligibility for Auxiliary Services is determined on a case by case basis. Referral for services may be initiated by parents or school personnel. Intervention is available individually or in small groups, and may be provided in the ARC and / or the regular classroom.
