Incarnation Playground Renovation Summer 2023





Why is a renovation needed?

- Current playground is 15-23 years old
 - Life expectancy of a playground is 20-25 years
- Originally sought repairs revealed larger problems
- Significant drainage problems
- Unseen damage under surface

- Mulch degrades and washes away
 - Ruins clothing and shoes
 - Messy in school
- Flats and other areas have coating worn away
- Breakage
- Safety elements to be included in new design



Why Now?

- Current playground passes inspection but won't in the near future
- Planned for much smaller repairs but condition demands action for continued safety of children
- Lead time is nine-twelve months
- Timing for summer work



"Playgrounds are essential safe spaces where children can be themselves and express their funloving nature while developing crucial cognitive, physical, social and emotional skills." ~ Little Tykes

How did we arrive at this cost?

- Four bids were obtained
- Chose PlayCare Playground Solutions
 - Catholic owned
 - Reputation with Catholic schools and organizations within Archdiocese
 - Received over a 30% discount due to being a Catholic School through their programming

- PlayCare will complete the entire job
 - Demo is extensive looked at other possibilities
 - Excavation to eight-ten feet to correct drainage
 - Back fill with substrate and soil
 - Solid surface installed vs. mulch
 - Concrete pathway surrounding

Total Cost Breakdown:

Removal of old playground structure:\$18,000Repair of drainage and rebuilding the foundation:\$88,560Install of new playground and structure:\$143,818Install of new solid play surface:\$100,800Landscaping, concrete, and additional security features:\$45,000+



How will we pay for the new playground?

- PTO paid the \$50,000 deposit
- Day of Giving resulted in \$99,250
 - All donors on Day of Giving are Crusader Club members
- PTO Fund-Raising Efforts above and beyond \$105,000:
 - The FRY
 - Crusader Classic
 - Trivia Night
- Grants
 - Have already received one for \$2,500
- Received \$1,500 Gift from Catholic Organization




